## **Instructions for completing the Stakeholder Registration Form**

A single registration form should be completed for each individual who wishes to register as a stakeholder.

### **Section 1: Stakeholder Contact Details**

This section seeks contact information for an individual or an individual within a company or organisation. The database allows the recording of a range of information including contact telephone numbers and an electronic mail address. There is space for both postal and street addresses if these are different. A street address is required should a delivery service other than Australia Post be used. We encourage stakeholders to use electronic mail where possible to receive information on biosecurity matters.

### **Section 2: Stakeholder Categorisation**

This section contains a request to identify the single most appropriate category of stakeholder. By identifying stakeholders by category it is possible to better target the distribution of information.

### **Section 3: Stakeholder Participation / Expertise**

Most changes to or reviews of established biosecurity policy require an import risk analysis (IRA) conducted in-house by Biosecurity Australia, with consultation with Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry, scientists and other experts both inside and outside Biosecurity Australia as required. More complex proposals will involve appointment of an expert Risk Analysis Panel to consider the issues. The panel will also consult with scientists and other experts as appropriate.

This section seeks to identify stakeholders who are experts in a field relating to a particular commodity IRA under consideration and who would like to apply their expertise in the IRA process. It is envisaged that technical expertise (for example science or economics) or detailed industry knowledge would be valuable in the process.

### **Section 4: Commodity Interests**

This information will be used to identify stakeholders who want to be kept informed of the progress of a biosecurity risk assessment process for specific commodities.

Stakeholders can identify their commodity interests specifically, such as Cattle, Orange or Crustaceans or identify their commodity interests generally, such as Livestock, Fruit, Citrus or Aquatic. Please tick all commodities that you are interested in receiving biosecurity information on.
